**JAMES REMILLARD SENTENCED TO ONE YEAR IN JAIL FOR NEGLIGENT
HOMICIDE/VEHICULAR ASSAULT CONVICTIONS**

Hillsborough County Attorney Dennis Hogan announces that on Friday, June 10, 2011, James Remillard, age 20, was sentenced to one year at the Hillsborough County House of Corrections and a consecutive 3 ½ to 7 suspended state prison sentence by Honorable Judge Brian Tucker in Hillsborough County Superior Court (Northern District). The defendant pled guilty today to Negligent Homicide and Vehicular Assault. On May 8, 2010, the defendant drove a motor vehicle at a speed of at least 70 mph on Old Hancock Road in Antrim, N.H. The defendant lost control of the vehicle and collided with a tree. The defendant had two female passengers in the vehicle at the time. One of the passengers was killed in the collision and the other was seriously injured.

The defendant will serve one year at the Hillsborough County House of Corrections. He will then be on probation for two years. He must complete 200 hours of community service in the area of safe driving and his license is revoked for a minimum of 7 years. He also received a consecutive suspended state prison sentence of 3 ½ to 7 years. That sentence is suspended for a period of five years upon his release from the House of Corrections.

Assistant Hillsborough County Attorney Jennifer Sandoval represented the State in the prosecution.
